PROJECT DETAILS

On April 1, 2016, Governor Cuomo and Legislative leaders adopted the largest multi-year State Transportation Plan ever approved in New York.

The Plan invests more than \$55 billion in new transportation improvements, including \$27.1 billion for the Department of Transportation and Thruway Authority programs and \$28.0 billion for the Metropolitan Transportation Authority's program. Specifically, the Department of Transportation's five-year capital plan includes \$21.1 billion in funding to improve highway, bridge, rail, port, airport and downstate suburban and upstate transit infrastructure.

The new State Transportation Plan also provides unprecedented support for local governments to maintain and improve roads and bridges. As part of this plan, groups of bridges were bundled into project packages. Halmar was awarded low bidder of the Region 8 Bridges for Dutchess and Columbia Counties (BINs 1091510, 1006480, 1040040, 1032330, 1027160 and 1032290).

The work envisioned for this project will include six full bridge replacements which will include demolition of the existing structures and complete construction of the replacement bridges. Highway work for the full replacement bridges will include approach work to tie into the new structures.

SCOPE

- Removal of the existing substructures and superstructures
- Replacement of the existing bridges; including new foundations, substructures, superstructures and approach slabs
- Approach roadway reconstruction necessary to connect existing roadways to new bridge

- Development of a WZTC plan for each site
- Coordination, preservation, relocation or remediation/disposal of all or any of the following: existing utilities; asbestos, lead based paint and water quality
- Fabrication and installation of new guide rail and bridge barrier/rail
